As a new member you have been assigned a Sponsor who will help you to integrate into the club. To fly at this airport you must have been properly trained and soloed. You also must sign the airport's seven-page waiver. You can be recommended to fly out of Perris Ultralight Airpark by an FBO flight instructor or the Ultralight Club.

As a new member you are placed on a 90 day probation period during which time your participation in the club and presence at the field will be observed. After 90 days the general membership will be asked to vote you into the general membership with all privileges thereto.

You must do the following to be voted in to the club.

1. Get your picture taken for the picture board and the website.
2. Write a one page biographic about yourself to be published in the Ultralog.
3. Assist in one or more of the following for 3 months:
  - ◆ Competition – event set up and scoring
  - ◆ Vice President – pick up sandwiches for meeting; get drinks
  - ◆ Sergeant-at-Arms – clean club house before meeting, set up chairs
4. You must attend 3 consecutive club meetings
