## **New Member Welcome and Instruction**

Copies of the Club By-Laws, seven-page Airport Liability Waiver and the ultralight field flight pattern are to be obtained from our website at [www.ultralightsquadron.org](http://www.ultralightsquadron.org). Review the by-laws and waver, print the entire wavier and initial/sign where indicated and print and initial/sign the last page of the by-laws and turn both in to your sponsor. The seven-page airport liability waiver must be signed before you can bring an aircraft onto the Airport property. Give the signed waiver and last page of the by-laws to the Club Secretary.

The Club Sergeant-At-Arms will assign to you a club member to be your sponsor if you do not already have one. Your sponsor will be responsible for introducing you to the club area, the club members, and insure your smooth transition into the club. Your sponsor will also be responsible for insuring that you understand the airport pattern, entry and egress procedureds and will accompany you on your first flights to familiarize you with the pattern and the local area. If your sponsor cannot be available please do not hesitate to ask a fellow club member to assist you or answer any questions you have. We are all here to insure you have a safe and fun flying experience.

Regarding monthly dues and tie-down fees, you are expected to keep current. Current (paid-up dues/tie-down) members are called members in good standing. Most members pay ahead their dues and tie-down fees. The tie-down fee is assessed by the Airport manager and is due each month. The club treasurer collects the dues for the club and tie-down fees for the Airport. If you are in arrears in your dues three months you will be removed from the club roster. If you are in arrears in your tie-down fees three months your plane will be removed from the club area and turned over to the Airport manager for disposition of your debt to the Airport.

Club fees (dues and tie-down) are paid to the Club Treasurer. They can be paid at the club meeting or mailed to:
