## Driving directions from Perris Airport to Borrego Valley Airport

Way #1:

Hwy 115 south to  
Hwy 15 south to  
Hwy 79 south to  
S2 (San Felipe Rd) to  
Hwy 78 east to  
S3 (Yaqui Pass Rd) to  
Borrego Valley Rd north (Borrego Valley) to  
Palm Canyon Dr east (S22/Borrego Valley) to  
Borrego Valley Airport

Way #2:

Hwy 115 south to  
Hwy 15 south to  
Hwy 79 south to  
S2 (San Felipe Rd) to  
S22  
Palm Canyon Dr east (Borrego Valley)  
Borrego Valley Airport

Way #1 looks more complicated but it is not. It is slightly longer in distance but you miss the steep and winding grade on S22 into Borrego Valley. No really steep grades and is a much easier drive. The aircraft will fly more along this route.

Way #2 is nice until you descend out of the mountains west of Borrego Valley down into the city. S22 is steep and winding and not a lot of fun for RV's or pulling trailers. Don't worry because it has been done at one time or another by everybody.
